OCL presents program about teen drugs at 4 branches in June

TOMS RIVER - Ocean County Library will present a program at four branches to help parents, guardians and educators recognize the signs and clues that their teen might be using drugs.

The program, led by police veteran and experienced law enforcement trainer Joseph Pangaro, will show what drugs and their associated paraphernalia look like and what hidden clues to look for in homes and cars. He will also discuss what drugs are trending in our area, including increased heroin usage in the teen population.

Pangaro will examine the markers to watch for that are warning signs of possible drug use and its symptoms, including depression, withdrawal, hostility, changes in friends, and an increased secrecy about possessions and activities.

Continuing Education credits are available for educators who attend any of these programs.
