Performer Marvin Jefferson will provide an entertaining and informative program at the Upper Shores Branch of the Ocean County Library, portraying York who accompanied Clark during his three-year expedition with Meriwether Lewis to the Pacific Ocean in 1803.

Jefferson brings a powerful stage presence and in-depth first person characterization of York, whose unique features and strength were viewed with astonishment and awe by Native Americans.
