TOMS RIVER – Discover the extensive array of support programs available through the Ocean County Office of Senior Services during an Ocean County Library virtual presentation at 2:30 PM Thursday, September 23.

The county office's mission is to improve access to available services, to promote healthy aging, to foster greater independence, to support family caregivers, and to advocate at the local, state and federal level.

In Toms River, the Office of Senior Services is centered at 1027 Hooper Avenue and assigns representatives to the County Connection in the Ocean County Mall. Resource Centers can be found in Lakewood, Manahawkin, and Whiting.
