Debby also supplies costumed characters, glitter tattoos, face painting, and magic shows, and conducts Teddy Bear building events and pallet painting parties.

"I started [learning balloon art] when I was in high school," said Debby, who later earned a college degree in business management. "I always loved making people happy, so it was natural to open my own company."
