Pinelands Flora and Fauna at Ocean County Library Long Beach Island Branch

SURF CITY – Pinelands Flora and Fauna will be presented by Joel M. Mott, Principal Public Programs Specialist for the NJ Pinelands Commission at the Long Beach Island Library Friday, August 4 at 2 PM.

This presentation includes the sights and sounds of the Pinelands while taking the audience on a walk in the woods familiarizing them with the wildlife of the legendary Pine Barrens.

Over the years living and working in the area Mott has experienced many of these upclose and will discuss iconic species like the Pine Barrens tree frog and the Timber rattle snake but also include lesser-known inhabitants like the Flying squirrel and Bushy beard grass.
