Located on the 2nd floor, accessible by elevator for convenience, Bay Head Express will be open Monday – Friday, 9AM – 4PM; with the book drop available 24/7 on the first floor upon entry into the building.

Express services available include ordering, pick up and drop off of library books and materials, library cards issued and renewed and a collection of popular books, DVDs, audio books, and Playaway® launch pads.

Mayor Bill Curtis was very excited to see the opening of the Bay Head Express location, and had this to say, "The Ocean County Library has created a wonderful solution for our Bay Head community. The library facilities here at Borough Hall will enable our residents to come in and pick out a book, and they can order any library materials they want.
